

Drop-off/Arrival/Pickup Procedures

- Parents are asked before arrival to be alert for any symptoms of COVID-19 and to keep child(ren) home if showing any signs of illness.
- We will restrict families' access to the welcome desk on the 1st and 2nd floor of the children's building.
- We are asking that one parent come to the welcome desk to sign in your child(ren).
- A staff member will be there to sign your child(ren) in and print the id sticker and pick-up sticker.
- You will put your child(ren) sticker on their back and a staff member will guide your child(ren) to their classrooms.
 - With exception to the Baby and 1 & 2-year-old classrooms.
 - One parent will be allowed once screening process is completed to take a child(ren) under two to their classroom.
- It is suggested that the same parent or designated person drop off and pick up the child.
- Hand hygiene stations are setup at the welcome desk on the 1st and 2nd floor of the children's building.
- This will allow leaders and children to clean their hands before they enter hallway and during class time.
- Pickup Procedures
 - We are asking the same parent (if possible, to pick up the child(ren) that dropped them
 off)
 - o Parents will go to the welcome desk on the 1st or 2nd floor with your pickup sticker.
 - You will give this sticker to the staff member working the desk. They will call down the hallway for your child.
 - o Your child(ren)s teacher will send them to the welcome desk for you to pick up.
 - Exception is the babies, 1, and 2-year-old classrooms.

Preventing the spread within the facility

- Classrooms should include the same children in the group each day and the same childcare providers.
- Follow proper hand hygiene guidance for adults and children such as washing hands frequently with
 - soap and water for at least 20 seconds (about as long as it takes to sing "Happy Birthday" twice). In addition to usual handwashing, make sure to wash hands:
 - o upon arrival in classroom in the morning
 - o before and after eating snacks
 - o after blowing noses, coughing, or sneezing or when in contact with body fluids
 - o after toileting or changing diapers
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth.
- When a child is finished with a mouthed toy, remove it, place it in a toy bin that is inaccessible to other children, and wash hands. Clean and sanitize toys before returning to children's area.
- All staff members and children (older than two years old) may wear protective face mask.
 - o We are not requiring the protective face mask, but you may wear them if you choose.
