Generations Following Update with Steven Bacon, Chair

By now you may have heard that the church family enthusiastically voted to move forward with the plan to construct a new student and young adult building. The "Generations Following" project was approved back in 2018, but with all the changes over the last two years it was wise for us to review the financial changes to the project. The team is thankful for your support, guestions, and concerns raised during the discussions.

The team has been diligently working on various aspects of the project since the decision. Pellicano was selected as the construction contractor to work with our construction team led by Robert Rainey. Please be in prayer for that team as they start their face-to-face meetings with the contractor to discuss the next phases of construction. Our contract with Pellicano will be contingent on a approved financial appraisal.


We have received initial approval for a loan through United Bank pending completion of the appraisal. Once that phase of the process is complete we will be in a better position to determine a construction start date. We ask that you pray for this part of the process and the forthcoming groundbreaking.

God has blessed us with funds in the amount of \$1,502,651.21 through November of 2021. As discussed during the church conference, we will use the majority of our existing funds to begin construction and will only draw from the loan when it is absolutely necessary. You continue to give generously to the campaign and we are prayerful that giving continues to allow us to reduce the amount required to borrow from the bank. Monthly giving in 2021 to "Generations Following" has been in excess of what is needed to make monthly loan payments once that time comes. We pray for continued financial commitment to the progress of reducing our financial liability.














a word of thanks
