



Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of

the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Matthew 28:19-20

Jesus' call to make disciples and be servant DISCIPLES. leaders is all-inclusive. He calls every Christian in every time and place to take the message of new life in Christ into every sphere of their lives. Matthew uses some language here that suggests that this GOING that we are to be doing refers to our day to day. As we have celebrated Annie Armstrong during the month of April, I hope you were

We must decide if we will wait until next year to think about missions or if we will engage in missions today! That's right, you have been called to GO and MAKE DISCIPLES.
