Justin & Michaela Knippers Asian Pacific Rim Peoples

As new IMB missionaries to Osaka, Japan, Justin and Michaela Knippers found their point of connection through virtual reality games. Unlike most video games, the whole point of VRChat is to connect and talk to people. Michaela said most players in the game are lonely and looking for a solution to their problems. For some, escaping into virtual worlds becomes the norm. This severe social withdrawal, anxiety, and reclusiveness is so common in Japan there's even a word for it-hikikomori. "Virtual reality evangelism isn't really any different from regular evangelism,' Justin said, explaining how it works. "You find a common point, build a relationship, and draw the conversation to the gospel." The couple team up to be a steadfast missionary presence through digital innovations. They recognize their unique interests and skills in the gaming world mean they might be the only ones sharing the gospel with those in the virtual world where they serve.

PRAY God would help the Knippers learn Japanese so they can transition relationships from online to the real world.

Malachi 2:17-3:4

¹⁷You have wearied the Lord with your words. But you say, "How have we wearied him?" By saying, "Everyone who does evil is good in the sight of the Lord, and he delights in them." Or by asking, "Where is the God of justice?"

3 ¹"Behold, I send my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me.
