South Asian Peoples

Most people in this South Asian village were afraid to seek medical attention, and the closest hospital is 15 miles away. Now, thanks to a South Asian doctor people call "Lucky," villagers have access to medical and soul care. While studying to be a doctor, Lucky heard the gospel from IMB missionaries Cordy and Elise Lowe and decided to commit his life to Christ. Cordy and Lucky regularly go into communities to talk about their faith. Because of their friendship with Lucky, the Lowes were able to share the gospel in areas they otherwise would not have had access to. The Lowes and Lucky have hosted medical clinics in the neighboring villages where they get phone numbers and follow up with patients. Cordy said many people in these areas have never heard the name of Jesus. That is quickly changing as the message spreads.
