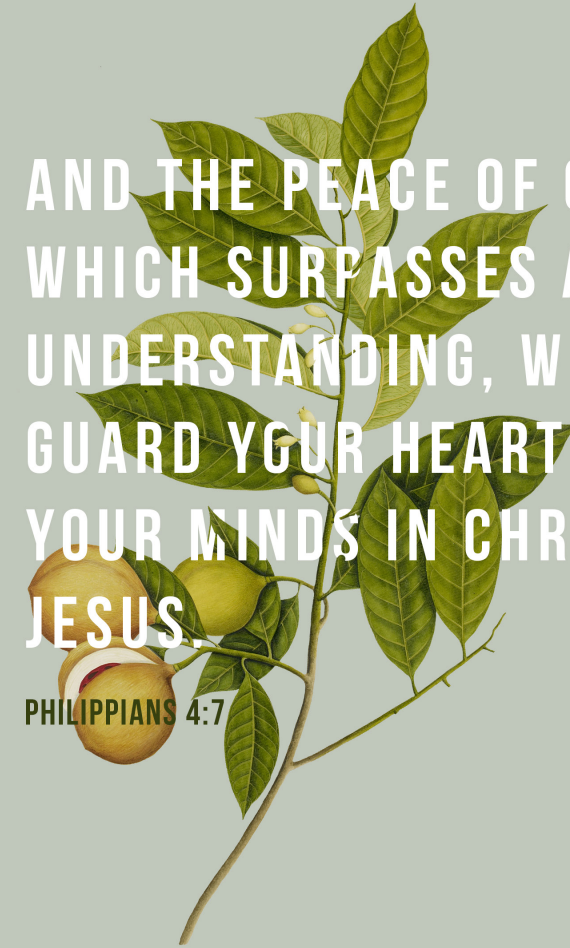
FBC WAYS TO WIN: GENEROSITY
