IMB missionary Matthew Fisher uses his training from the Trauma Healing Institute to make trauma healing groups a cornerstone of his church-planting strategy in South America. The work starts with a local believer God has called to plant a church. While many in the community may hesitate to join a new church, they are drawn to the authenticity and community found in trauma healing groups, known as sanando corazones or "healing hearts." In these free counseling sessions, participants share their stories, build strong bonds, and experience emotional and spiritual healing. Through addressing their emotional wounds in a program grounded in Scripture, many come to faith in Christ. As the group grows, it transitions from meeting on weekdays to gathering on Sunday mornings. The church-planting believer leads the fellowship, guiding group members through messages on what makes a healthy church. The group explores topics like identity in Christ, baptism, and worship, and members often answer God's call to take on roles within the church.
