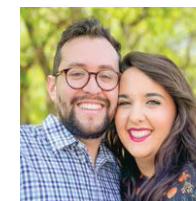

Emma and Francisco Pirela
 Clarkston, GA

Emma Pirela and her husband, Francisco, serve among refugees in Clarkston, Georgia, a hub for a refugee settlement just outside Atlanta. Each year, around 2,000 refugees worldwide are resettled in the one square mile of Clarkston. The Pirelas work with families settling into a new life. They help meet needs, build relationships, and share the love of Christ in the hope of seeing gospel transformation. Refugees have left a lot behind—their homes, communities, and often their families. Emma relayed a story about a dear friend. "Hadya is an Afghan [woman] around my age. When I met her, she had only been here for six months. She was due to have a baby soon, but her husband was still stuck in their country. Hadiya shared how hard it has been to be separated from her husband. While sitting in her apartment sipping tea, I shared about Jesus and His gospel. I explained how Jesus sees us and knows our hurts, pains, and needs. She listened intently and wanted to know more about Jesus."

MAIN QUESTION: Why is the concept of _____ important for the disciple of Christ?

1. Jesus _____ every disciple to be a witness to His perfect reclamation project (**Matthew 28:16-20**).

¹⁶Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. ¹⁷And when they saw him, they worshiped him, but some doubted. ¹⁸And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

2. The Holy Spirit, working through the disciple, _____ the efforts of His perfect reclamation project (**Acts 1:6-8**).

⁶So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" ⁷He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. ⁸But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

3. The hope for _____ for everyone hangs in the balance of His perfect reclamation project being accomplished (**John 3:16-18**).

¹⁶"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God."
