South Asian Peoples

Two thousand years ago, Jesus met a woman at a well in Samaria, offering her the good news of His love and grace. Today, in a South Asian village, a woman who was unable to read or write shared that same message with six other women at a well using an Ek Rasta SD card, meaning “The Way.” International Mission Board missionaries Brooks and Julia West use Ek Rasta SD cards to share the gospel and help believers grow, especially in regions where nearly 50 percent of the population is illiterate. These SD cards contain audio lessons in the local language, guiding listeners through the Bible from creation to the new creation in Revelation. The Wests aim to equip the local church to distribute these cards. One group reported sharing with more than 170 people in just four weeks. “It’s special when a believer who cannot read or write realizes God can still work powerfully through them,” Brooks said.
