IMB missionary Ruby Ng knows firsthand the experience of being a refugee. As a child, the Vietnam War devastated her homeland, forcing her to flee at 18. She escaped by boat and spent two years in a refugee camp, where she was introduced to Jesus by missionaries who were also fleeing Vietnam. Ruby left the camp as a new follower of Christ and relocated to Fort Worth, Texas, where she joined a church led by Peter, a young Vietnamese seminary student. Three years later, Ruby and Peter were married, and eventually, God called them to return to the nations as missionaries. Now, with more than 25 years of service as IMB missionaries in Taiwan, the couple focuses on reaching Vietnamese immigrants, particularly women. Many of these women left Vietnam at a young age, seeking better opportunities, but often find themselves in difficult circumstances, such as unhappy marriages or abuse. The Ng's church plant has become a refuge for many of these women.
