South Asian Peoples

IMB missionaries Owen and Mila Stoddard moved to South Asia when their son. Jamin. was just six months old. By the time he was two, they noticed significant developmental delays, and they later met with a speech-language pathologist who was invited by IMB's educational consultant for Asia to offer learning assessments at a conference. Jamin's results showed he was in the lowest percentile in many areas, and Mila feared they might need to leave the missions field. However, the consultant reassured them that support would be provided to help Jamin make progress. IMB worked closely with the Stoddards, creating a plan with the United States-based pathologist to support Jamin's development. Overwhelmed but committed, the family decided to try the plan for one year and reassess. "There were times I would curl up and crv. but every time, the Lord filled me up. He was so faithful," Mila said. Each vear, Jamin showed remarkable improvement, allowing the Stoddards to remain on the missions field. They credit God's provision and generous givers for helping their family continue their ministry in South Asia.


