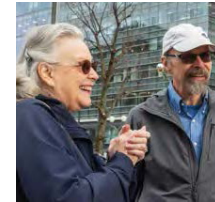

Carlton & Cornelia Walker

Asian Pacific Rim Peoples

Cornelia Walker learned about Japan when she was in Girls' Auxiliary (now Girls in Action). At the time, she could never have imagined she'd pour more than 40 years of her life into loving and serving the people she first learned about as a child. After she and her husband, Carlton, married, God called them to serve overseas. They learned of a need for new missionaries in Japan when many International Mission Board workers who had moved there after World War II retired. "I think we both looked at each other and said, 'What about us? We can go,' " Cornelia shared. The seeds of that initial willingness to serve have blossomed into decades of fruitful ministry. After 21 years serving in Hokkaido, Japan's northernmost province, the Walkers moved to Tokyo. A few years ago, their story in Japan came full circle when they were asked to move back to Hokkaido to mentor a new team of missionaries. Just as when they first arrived more than 40 years ago, they are confident God is still at work in Japan. "We have a tendency to look at those that have served for a while, and we focus on their faithfulness," Carlton explained. "But my goodness, the bigger story is God's faithfulness. He's the One that gets the praise, the honor, and the glory."
