## MISSION FOCUS



**Fred & Casey Weymouth**  
Tappahannock, VA

Casey was an occasionally employed bartender in Richmond, VA, who lived with a substance use disorder and was sometimes homeless. "It all started one night when I got off work at the bar, and I can't explain it; I just came to the end of myself," Casey shared. "I cried out to God even though I didn't really know who He was, and I told Him I'd had enough." Before she knew what was happening, Casey was on a one-way Greyhound bus back home to Momma, who was "the only Christian I'd ever known." Five hundred miles away at Richmond City Jail, her on-again, off-again boyfriend Fred was on a similar spiritual journey and was recovering from heroin addiction. "A man came in and preached the gospel," Fred recalled, "and something got rearranged in me. I traded a guy two honey buns for his Bible, and then for the next year, I just sat in my cell and fell in love with God's Word." After Fred was released from jail, he and Casey reunited, got married, and decided to go back to where they came from. They started by taking biscuits to some of Fred's old buddies living under a freeway overpass, which turned into a Bible study. When people started coming to the Lord, God provided for the creation of The Fix, a residential recovery and discipleship program that developed into a church plant.
