Scotty and Jessica Santiago serve as chaplains through Passion for Prison, ministering to those currently, formerly, or potentially incarcerated. They bring encouragement through Scripture cards, sent to individuals who are incarcerated on their birthdays and at Christmas, and share the gospel where others may not go-riding motorcycles inside prisons across Florida. Jessica says most in prison don't care about God or church, but many come out to see a motorcycle-and that opens the door to share Christ. Each week, the Santiagos lead a two-hour discipleship-based chapel service focused on spiritual growth. They also encourage those who are incarcerated to stay in touch after release. "We either attend their church or take them with us," Jessica said. "That helps us make sure they're connected to a Christ-centered church and allows us to continue mentoring them."
